

# ART WITH A HEART

## Community Art Camp

During the month of July, join Art with a Heart for our four week Community Art Camp. Participants will work with Ali Mirsky, Art with a Heart's Director of Community Service and Public Art and her assistant, Madison Krchnavy on public art projects to be installed in the Baltimore community.\*

Campers will receive guidance and instruction on the following skills:

- Glass cutting
- Creating mosaics
- Grouting
- Ceramics
- Glazing

Each week, Campers will work on public art projects including:

- Benjamin Franklin High School Wings
- Weinberg Library Mosaics
- Baer School Mosaic Sign
- Paper Butterfly Mural for TurnAround
- Heart of Baltimore sculpture for Baltimore City

Participants must be 13 years of age or older.

### **Participation Fee:**

\$500 for four weeks

OR

\$150 per week

### **Dates:**

July 6th through July 31st on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays for EITHER the morning session or the afternoon session each week.

### **Time:**

Morning Session - 10:00 am to 12:30 pm

OR

Afternoon Session - 2:00 pm to 4:30 pm

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## General Camp Information

- Weather permitting, Camp will be held outdoors following social distance protocols. If the weather does not allow us to be outside, the Camp will be held in the garage of our building or in a large open space inside the Art with a Heart office.
- Enrollment is limited to seven students per session on a first-come, first-served basis. Each session will have two to three Art with a Heart staff present at all times.
- Art with a Heart will provide snacks.
- Participants should wear comfortable closed toed shoes and comfortable clothing. Participants should bring: a water bottle; hat; sunscreen; small towel; mask.
- Participants (or Parents/Guardians for participants 17 and younger) will be required to complete and submit an Information Form and a Release Form prior to the start of Camp.

## Required COVID Protocols

- Each participant must bring and wear a face mask at all times while at Camp.
- A mandatory questionnaire and temperature screening will be required before each session.
- Participants may not bring anyone with them unless accompanying someone who needs special assistance. Please let us know in advance if this is the case.
- Students will be assigned mosaic supplies and tools for their exclusive use during their time in the program. The tools will be cleaned prior to distribution and at the end of each session.
- Disposable gloves will be available for all participants.
- Hand sanitizer will be placed throughout the space and available for frequent use.
- The entire office is cleaned each evening and between sessions including tables, chairs, bathrooms, computers in accordance with CDC infection control guidelines.
